PRIEST  
 (to DANIELS, bored)  
 Go on, piss off.

WOOLLEY hurries over from the stage.

WOOLLEY  
 What's the problem?

DANIELS  
 No problem, Mr. Woolley - just a  
 word of advice to my fellow artistes.

DANIELS manoeuvres WOOLLEY to one side, allowing the  
 UNDERTAKERS to march on stage.

DANIELS  
 Which just leaves us to settle  
 up the fifteen quid -

26 INT. JACKORANDA - STAGE. NIGHT. *1st day.* 26

ROY PRIEST and the UNDERTAKERS raise a subdued applause  
 as they launch into their opening number. STOKER  
 provides his lead vocals with a ghoulish vibretto  
 wail emanating from within the confines of the coffin.

27 INT. DANIEL'S CAR - TRAVELLING. NIGHT. 27

DANIELS drives along, passing out the Group's reduced  
 share of the evening's takings.

DANIELS  
 It's a bleedin' insult to talent  
 like us, ten quid!

BARRY hands out the money to the other two.

28 INT. JACKORANDA - STAGE. NIGHT. *1st day* 28

The UNDERTAKERS reach the high point of their act, and  
 PRIEST moves with ceremonious tread towards the coffin,  
 backed by a suitable drum roll.

PRIEST  
 (singing)  
 Oh Death, where is thy sting?  
 Oh, Grave, where is thy Victory?

STOKER emits a low wail in response, and a cloud of green  
 smoke announces his timely resurrection.
